Pinecone Bird Feeder

Pinecone bird feeders are easy to make and your garden birds will love them. If you have any allergy concerns you can substitute the peanut butter for soy butter, sunflower seed butter or coconut oil.

Materials

Pinecone (large, open pinecones work best)

String or wool

Peanut butter (or allergy-safe alternative)

Bird seed



Instructions

- 1. Cut a piece of string or wool and tie it around the top of your pinecone. Tie the ends of the string together to create a loop to hang your pinecone.
- 2. Take a scoop of peanut butter and spread it over your pinecone.
- 3. Roll your pinecone in the bird seed so the peanut butter is covered.



- 4. Leave your birdseed pinecone in a cool place to dry.
- 5. Hang your birdfeeder outside and await your garden visitors.
